This year has produced **abundant growth** in our **prevention** and **empowerment** programs, as well as continued funding for critical **fistula repair surgeries**. This concise report highlights some of the most exciting aspects of this year's impact and is filled with beautiful stories of hope **you** helped us write.

Dayana, age 15, is the fifth child in a large family with little financial means. After laboring several days without delivering a baby, her family brought her to the Wellness Clinic (Goma, DRC) for an emergency cesarean delivery. The result? Healthy mom and baby! Even though her family lacked the needed funds, she still received quality, life-saving care through the Maternal Health Fund you continue to replenish with your investments.



Our three Maternal Health Funds (DRC: 1, Angola: 2) are a significant and effective fistula prevention avenue. The most active fund is through our partnership with the Wellness Clinic in Goma, DRC that helped Dayana in the above story. As of August 2019, your investments funded 244 cesarean deliveries this year in Goma alone! In addition to preventing fistula, the Clinic's "ability to provide a timely and needed c-section is key...to reducing maternal and infant mortality," says Dr. Myron Glick of the Jericho Road Community Center, founding organization of the clinic. By funding fistula prevention, you have the opportunity to play an active role in our sisters' desire for hope and health, and the overall wellness of their communities.

Due to **your generosity**, we also experienced **great abundance** through our events, our first HFOS Donor/Team trip, and the "fruit" of our empowerment programs.

Thank you to everyone who participated in Generate Hope 2019! Whether you attended, invested, served or donated beautiful raffle items, you helped create a magical night of abundance where we raised over \$19,500 to fund our three Maternal Health Funds and the Ultrasound Empowerment Program (Angola). Dr. Priscila Cummings, medical partner from Kalukembe, Angola, and keynote speaker, inspired everyone in the room with her passion.
