

New Programs in 2021

While hope is generated by our ongoing programs, we are excited about new programs being launched in Angola. These include a Fistula Awareness Radio Program (COVID-safe awareness) and laundry and kitchen facilities (protecting the dignity of our sisters and providing healthy cooking education).

Additionally, as Silva, Petra, and Sara (pictured in that order) train government-sponsored nurses about fistula, they plan to develop much-needed Reintegration and Ambassador Programs for our sisters healed from fistula.

Sustainable Growth Through Education

A long-term hope is for all women in Angola, DR Congo, and Nepal to have access to timely and quality healthcare. One way to realize this hope is home-grown doctors and nurses. Dr. Tresor Mabanza (pictured with his wife, Blandine) graduated from his PAACS medical training in December 2020!
