Fistula Prevention is Why We Exist

Fistula from childbirth is **100% preventable**. A new data point from a May 2024 FIGO (International Federation of Gynecology & Obstetrics) article provides further support for our prevention focus. "Despite the nearly 100,000 new fistula cases that arise each year, and the million or more cases already existing, **only 1 in 50 women (with fistula) will receive treatment for fistula**." Deirdre (left) and all of our precious sisters deserve a **fistula-free world**.

New Doors are Opening

New doors are opening for Team Votoka ("Rise Up") in Angola. At the end of 2024, the team (Veronica, left, Mary, right) met with the Angolan Minister of Health (center) and signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Angolan Council of Christian Churches (CICA) about the church's role in fistula prevention. They are hosting a conference on this very topic this March. We are so excited for this forward movement and know there will be more to come!
